











HOW TO PREVENT SOTF EMAILS FROM GOING TO SPAM

Step	Action
1	<p>Log in to your email account to add <i>Sisters on the Fly</i> to your contacts list. In general, this will prevent their messages from going to your SPAM folder.</p> <p>Note: This how-to will demonstrate using GMAIL. In general, this same process will work for any email system. However, you can check https://www.itworld.com/article/2716761/how-to-make-sure-important-emails-never-get-sent-to-spam.html for details on other systems.</p> 
2	<p>Enter <i>Sistersonthe-fly.com</i> in the Search Mail text box.</p>  <p>Result: All mail from <i>sistersonthe-fly.com</i> will be displayed.</p> 
3	<p>Open any message from 'Sisters on the Fly.'</p>  <p>Result: The message will be displayed.</p>

<p>5</p>	<p>Click Add Sisters on the Fly to Contacts list.</p>  <p>Result: The following message will appear.</p>  <p>Note: Yahoo email is slightly different. In Yahoo, after clicking three dots, instead of adding Sisters to your contacts list, you will need to click 'Filter messages like this'</p>  <p>And then you will 'select a filter' for Sistersonthefly. You should select In box and, lastly, Save.</p>
