Handbook for Sisters on the Fly Adopt a Highway Campaign-using Wyoming as an example.

- Search your State by typing in "Wyoming Highway Department". My search result gave me <u>Wyoming Department of Transportation -</u> <u>WYDOT</u>, www.dot.state.wy.us
- Click on your State highway department. Do a search for Adopt a Highway.
 When I did so I got a complete description of the project, the regions available and contact information. You can see that here:

- 3. Choose the region you want to adopt to clean and contact the appropriate person to get started. I went for a drive after talking with my contact. He let me know what was available and I went and found just the right spot!
- 4. Go to our website and list your event. I personally sent an email to each active Sister in Wyoming and Montana. I had 4 Sisters participate with only one local Sister doing so. I also had three misters participate, including my own.
- 5. Let your area coordinator know of the date you plan to clean so they can have the appropriate supplies in hand for your event.
- 6. It took us 3.5 hours to clean 4 miles with many, many bags of trash and some treasures!
- 7. Now, get out there and do this....a great community service project and an even better way to be in the great outdoors while making your state beautiful.
